Description (max. 100 words)	Master's thesis involves a formal self-designed research on a chosen topic, conducted under the mentor's supervision and submitted in written form. It consists of the following sections: table of contents, introduction, theoretical framework/literature review, methodology, research, results, discussion, conclusion, references. The topic chosen must be related to the curriculum, i.e. the fields of study covered (security and criminalistics). The topic is chosen by the student, and approved by the mentor and the Academic Council. A master's thesis completion requires an oral defense evaluated by an academic committee consisting of the mentor and two members from the candidate's department.				
Learning outcomes (max. 50 words)	Having completed the master's thesis, students are qualified to carry out self-devised and designed scientific research at the master's level. They can choose a research problem, collect data, evaluate sources, apply methodology, analyse results and make conclusions. They can employ this knowledge in further education and professional work.
