<b>Description (max. 100 words)</b>	<p>This course is intended for students with no background in Italian language. It will introduce students to basic four skills (listening, speaking, reading, writing) and basic knowledge of vocabulary and grammar. The topics that will be covered are: alphabet; rules of reading and writing; definite and indefinite article; present tense of <i>avere</i> and <i>essere</i>; inflection of nouns; invariant nouns; present tense of the three conjugations; the most common irregular verbs in the present tense; expressions with <i>avere</i> and <i>essere</i>; personal pronouns; inflection of adjectives; articles, noun, and adjective agreement; cardinal numbers; prepositions of place <i>in, a, da</i> with <i>andare</i>.</p>
