Class system; education and school system; media; judiciary system and police. Church and religion. Historical development of USA society and culture; America today; institutions in USA. Short overview of the English language development.</p> <p>Practice: analyses of different articles, photographs, movies, in connection with the Anglo-American world, discussions.</p>
