It will further expand the basic lexical and grammatical knowledge and language skills within the B1 level of the Common European Framework. The topics that will be covered are: negative pronouns, demonstrative adjectives; demonstrative pronouns; <i>imperfetto</i> of regular and irregular verbs; difference between <i>passato prossimo</i> and <i>imperfetto</i>; <i>trapassato prossimo</i>; the three past tenses; imperative of regular verbs; imperative of irregular verbs; use of pronouns with the imperative; conjunctions; idioms; proverbs; English words in contemporary Italian.</p>
