<b>Description (max. 100 words)</b>	<p>This compulsory course is a direct continuation of <i>Introducing Legal English</i>. The objective is to further the students' knowledge of basic terminology and communication in Legal English, as well as to continue with the study of international law. Due to the complexity of the course, basic vocabulary, concepts and systems are explained in broad detail as has been done so far. Furthermore, differences and similarities between the Anglo-American and the Serbian law systems, concepts and procedures are explained. The acquired vocabulary is practised doing the reading and listening exercises, and through analyses of authentic texts of legal documents and statutes.</p>				
<b>Learning outcomes (max. 50 words)</b>	<p>Students have learned the necessary legal concepts and terminology relating to different kinds of contracts. They are now able to understand and translate contractual clauses in both language directions. They have an active command of terminology of Law of Contracts and Obligations, of issues concerning legal questions of labour relations, etc.</p>
