Description (max. 100 words)	<p>This course involves two parts. The first one - theoretical focuses on the wide repertoire of teaching techniques that are efficient in state school English teaching, whereas the second one that is practical takes place in schools where students get their first teaching experience under the supervision of the professor and the state school English teacher. Therefore, students start with revision and extension of the theoretical knowledge (lesson planning, teaching vocabulary, grammar, pronunciation, teaching skills, error correction, establishing discipline, etc.), then proceed with lesson planning and practical teaching experience.</p>

They are also well-trained to teach English in state schools and to employ teaching methods and techniques that are best suited to a particular age-group of learners.</p>
