Description (max. 100 words)	<p>The students are introduced to the theory of contrastive linguistics, the importance of linguistic models, the concepts of equivalence, correspondence, identity, similarity, contrast and difference. They study the types and classification of contrastive studies as well as the application of the obtained results in teaching and translation. Students are trained to perform analysis within the given linguistic model at the phonological, morphological and syntactic level, also at the discourse level. The assignments of writing essays on theoretical and practical issues are obligatory, summarising chapters from extended literature and close observation of language phenomena in English and Serbian.</p>				
Learning outcomes (max. 50 words)	<p>Students know to apply principles of contrastive linguistics within given linguistic models - structural, functional or transformational. The unit of analysis varies from morpheme to sentence, even text. They can use large corpora to establish principles of comparability and utilise concordance and collocation for the purpose of their individual analysis.</p>
