<b>Description (max. 100 words)</b>	<p>The aim of the course is to provide students with general and specific knowledge about the law of obligations, gaining knowledge of the structure of obligation relations, principles of regulating obligation relations and basic institutions of obligation rights. Students acquire basic knowledge about the most important obligations relationships established in turnover of goods and services between physical persons, legal entities, and legal entities and physical persons. They acquire specific legal skills in the system of protection of property rights and develop creative ability in order to improve relations between entities in obligation relations.</p>
