Description (max. 100 words)	<p>The objective of the course is to help its students acquire knowledge about the history of the Serbian people, legal history primarily; the meaning, importance and role of historical events in the contemporary legal and political systems. They learn about the legal and historical events in Serbia, from the struggle for independence in the First and the Second Serbian Uprisings, to the reign of King Petar I Karađorđević. The students become familiar with the sources of law in Serbia, acquiring the basic legal and historical terminology within the national context.</p>				
Learning outcomes (max. 50 words)	<p>Students have developed, using historical examples, their ability to understand law and state as social phenomena that arise, develop, or disappear. Positive law institutes are observed in historical context. Students are also able to collect and critically analyse relevant professional literature and normative materials in the field.</p>
