Description (max. 100 words)	The aim of this course is to introduce students to facts, topics, and phenomena of mental life and behavior from the psychology point of view. Students learn about psychology as a science and about its history. They also learn about relevant and recent data regarding psychology, neuroscience, and genetics – their phenomena and behavior, all of which will help them in their later courses. Furthermore, students are introduced to professional and scientific psychological beliefs in order to build their own professional integrity.
